- WE WILL SUPPORT AND BE RESPECTFUL TO ALL COACHES, BOARD MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS, TEAMMATES, PARENTS, OPPONENTS, AND OFFICIALS.
- WE WILL BE TEAM PLAYERS AND WILL WORK HARD TO IMPROVE OUR SKILLS. WE WILL LEARN THE RULES AND PLAY BY THEM.
- WE WILL BE A GOOD SPORT AND SET A POSITIVE EXAMPLE FOR OTHERS. WE WILL LEARN TO LOSE WITH DIGNITY AND TO WIN WITH GRACE.
- WE WILL REFRAIN FROM ANY VULGAR, LEWD, OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE OR GESTURES WHILE PARTICIPATING IN, OR WATCHING ANY NYSA SPONSORED EVENT WHETHER AT HOME OR AWAY.
- WE WILL NOT SMOKE, DRINK ALCOHOL OR USE ANY OTHER ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE; **FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE ORGANIZATION.**
- WE WILL NOT BADGER PLAYERS, SPECTATORS, OFFICIALS OR COACHES.
- WE WILL NOT ALLOW OUR PLAYERS OR COACH TO QUESTION THE UMPIRE'S CALLS.
- WE HONOR THE RULE THAT ONLY COACHES OR TEAM CAPTAINS ARE ALLOWED TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE UMPIRES. (THIS APPLIES TO ACTIONS BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THE GAME).
- WE UNDERSTAND THAT ANY BEHAVIOR THAT REFLECTS POORLY ON THE TEAM DURING ANY OFFICIAL NYSA FUNCTION WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AS DECIDED BY NYSA OFFICIALS.
- WE WILL BE ON TIME FOR SCHEDULE GAMES AND INFORM NYSA'S OFFICIALS IN ADVANCE WHEN RUNNING LATE FOR GAMES.
- WE UNDERSTAND THAT FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THIS CODE OF CONDUCT WILL AUTOMATICALLY RENDER PENALTY FOR YOUR TEAM AS IMPOSED BY NYSA.

TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The League is comprised of Female and Mixed Teams
2. **Mixed team is defined as a team consisting of a maximum of four (4) males on the court at one time with no more than two (2) males in the goal circles at any one time. E.g. two (2) defenders and no shooter, two (2) shooters and no defense player or one (1) shooter and one (1) defense.**
3. All teams can register a maximum of 15 players BUT only 12 players will be allowed to play on game days
4. A minimum of 5 players will be allowed to take the court for a game. Team having less than 5 players available for game time will lose points and the game will be forfeited and points awarded to opposing team.
5. If both teams do not have a minimum of 5 players to take the court at game time the game will be forfeited and the game will not be rescheduled.
6. League will consist of two zones - female and mixed. However all teams will meet to highlight the competitiveness of netball. The ranking of the teams will be categorized by zones for placement in the competition
7. **Eligibility**
 - Players are not allowed to play for more than one team during the tournament.
 - All players must be registered with waiver signed and included in the package prior to taking the court.
 - Entry fee must be paid by the date indicated in the package; Captains are responsible for collecting fees, and completing all paperwork and submitting said completed paperwork to NYSA secretary or treasurer. Confirmation of entry will be sent to the Captain via email
 - **Last opportunity to add players to a team is the week before the last regular season game.**
 - **All registered players must play in at least one regular season game to be eligible to play in the semi-finals and finals**

1) SAFETY ON COURT

- a) Pregnant players will not be allowed to actively participate in the competition. The concerned player has an obligation to inform tournament committee of her status and shall discontinue her participation from the competition.
- b) All participants are required to remove jewelry (no exceptions). If player(s) take the court with jewelry, said player(s) will be removed for a total of 1 goal.
- c) Participants must have low finger nails

2) CANCELLATIONS, POSTPONEMENTS, WALKOVERS & WITHDRAWALS

- a) The tournament official on duty shall have the authority to stop, cancel or postpone any games due to unforeseen circumstances.
- b) Any team giving a walkover shall notify NYSA at least 48 HOURS before any league game. When a team forfeits the game, 3 points shall be awarded to the opposing team.
- c) If a team fails to give 48 HOURS NOTICE for a league game walkover, the team will have the deduction of 2 points from the total accumulated points.
- d) Games affected by weather conditions such as rain will be delayed until NYSA officials deem the court safe for players to take the court. Both teams are required to be at the game location and arrive on time as specified by the original game schedule. **If the court is deemed unsafe NYSA's official will cancel the game and notify team leaders of new schedule within 48 hours after cancelation**

3) GAMES FIXTURES

- a) All League games shall consist of 4 quarters of 15 minutes. 2 minutes break between quarters and 5 minutes at half time.
- b) The tournament committee shall reserve dates, venues and times of all matches before the commencement of the competition.
- c) Teams shall receive the fixtures at least 5 working days before the competition begins.
- d) Circumstances and /or inclement weather - (See 2A)
- e) The game of Netball shall be played according to IFNA Rules AND rules specified by NYSA.
- f) 15 minutes grace period will be given only to teams that make that request 15 minutes prior to game time.
- g) Teams delaying to take the court at the sound of the umpire's whistle or request will not be allowed to take the court until the opposing team has scored one goal.
- h) Any walkovers shall be awarded by the presiding umpires
- i) The following scoring system shall apply for all league games:

Win – 3 points
Draw - 2 points
Lose - 0 point
Walkover - 3 points
ALL POINTS COUNT

4) UMPIRES

- a) NYSA will determine umpires for the league.
- b) Umpire(s) decisions are final

WEATHER

ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED AS SCHEDULED SUNSHINE OR RAIN. Schedule teams are required to check in at game location at the time specified on the game schedule. Games will be called from the location by a NYSA official.

5) DISCIPLINE

- a) The 2018 NYSA league will be governed by the INF rules in conjunction with NYSA's local rules
- b) The umpires concerned shall briefly indicate on the NYSA scorecards the names of the players sent off and the reasons. The umpires shall inform the Tournament Official after the game.
- c) At the end of each game, if there is a complaint, team captain must obtain a complaint form from the officials. Forms must be submitted on the same day of incident or within 24 hours to be considered valid. NYSA will not address any complaint submitted after the above specified time or address any complain made via phone.

- 6) **CLARIFICATIONS & INTERPRETATIONS** – Any concerns not provided for in these rules shall be dealt with by the tournament committee and in the event of any ambiguity and/or confusion in the interpretation and/or application of any rules, the tournament committee's interpretation/ruling shall be final.

7) DEFINITIONS

- a) **Goal Average** is calculated by taking the total goals scored by a team divided by the total number of goals scored against the said team.
- b) **Goal Difference** is the total goals scored by the team minus the total goals scored against the team in that Tournament
- c) **IFNA Rules** means the International Federation of Netball Association (IFNA)
- d) **Walkover** means forfeiting a game in favor of the opposing team.
